That's the news. See you all Thursday.

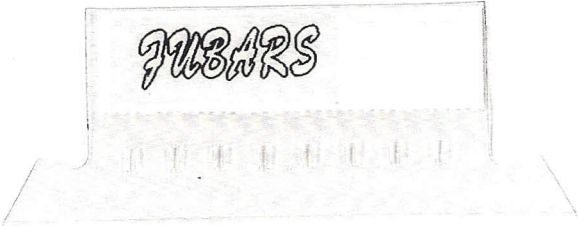

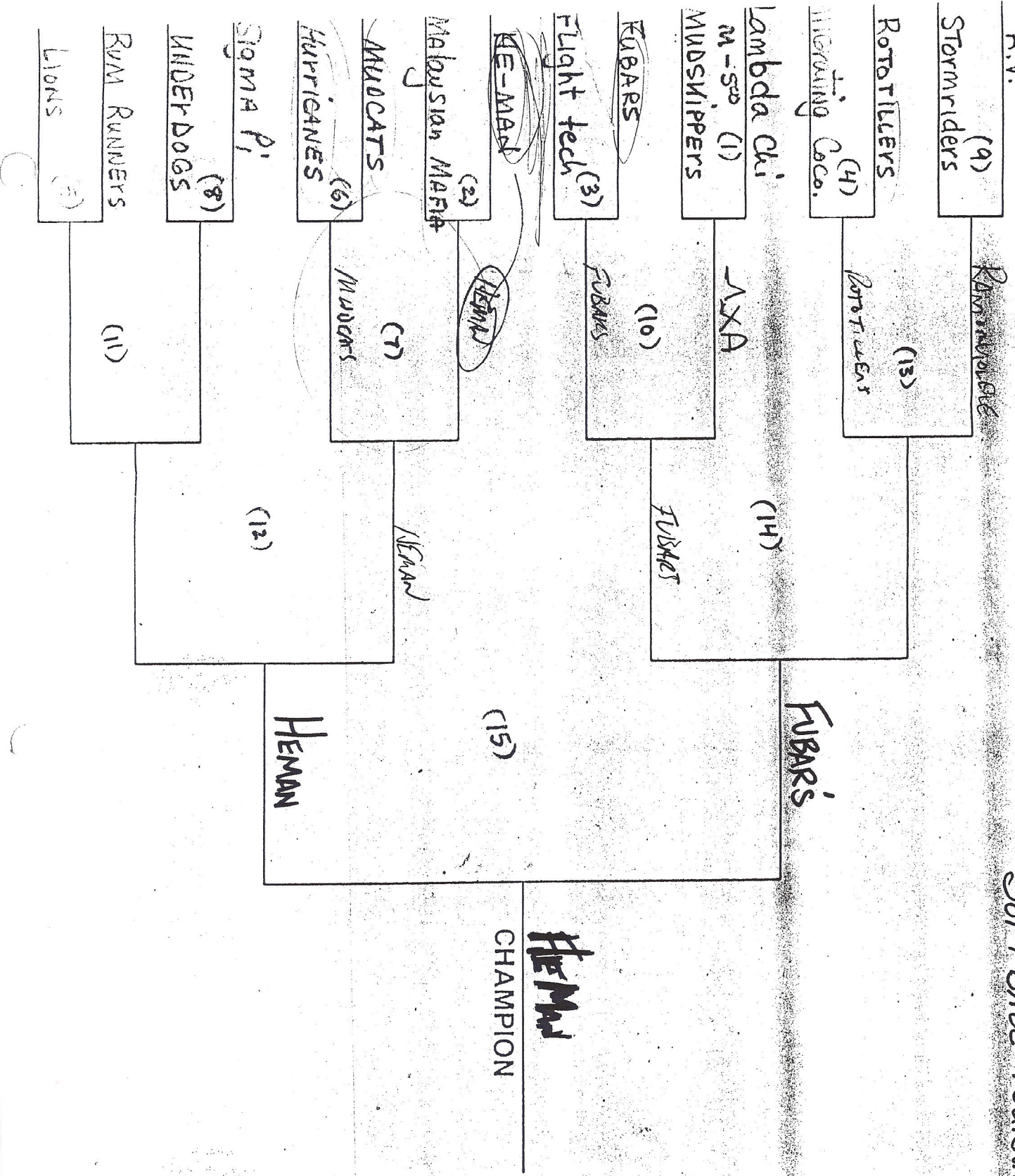
